

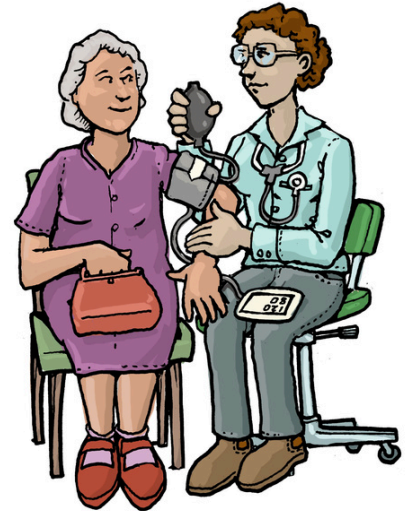
Calling all health workers!
