- (5) From here, you will start to see potential visitors start posting on your post thread.
- (6) If you'd like to connect, please continue with private messenging the person so that you will have a lovely visit.
- (7) If you have an unsatisfactory visit for any reason, please private message the group admins so that appropriate action can be taken.
